## Macro 5 SLR Camera

The Macro 5 SLR close-up camera is invaluable when you need detailed photographs of smaller subjects. When color nuances are important, such as when photographing bruises, burns or wounds, the Macro 5 SLR provides incredible detail, clarity and color accuracy. 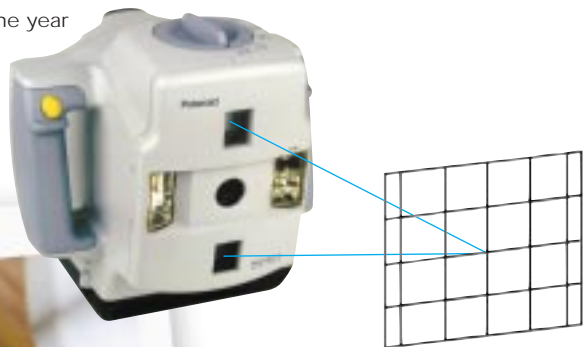

## HealthCam Kit

The Polaroid HealthCam Kit is ideally suited for applications such as measuring the recovery rate of leg ulcers and pressure sores. The HealthCam Kit includes an easy-to-use 1200si instant camera for full-body shots. Accessories, included in the kit and described below, also allow you to use this camera for close-ups of wounds and other injuries.

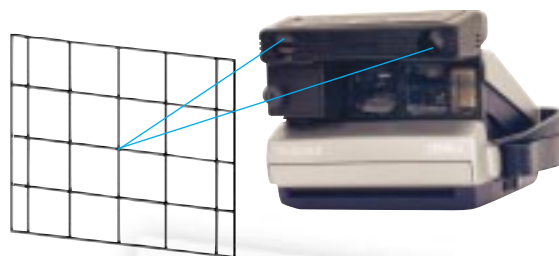
**Close-up lens:** a Light Lock lens that allows you to take detailed close-ups of injuries without touching the patient or victim

**Carrying case:** includes storage compartments for camera, lens and extra packs of film

**Polaroid color film:** Type 990 (recommended), Spectra or Grid Film

**Picture size:** 4 x 4.06 in. (Image area: 3.6 x 2.9 in.)

**Grid Film** You can also use Polaroid Grid Film, which produces an instant color print with a grid overlay of 192 squares. Grid Film is ideal for tracking the healing rate of wounds and sores. The squares are lettered A to P horizontally and 1 to 12 vertically, so taking comparison pictures at regular intervals clearly illustrates how a subject changes over a period of time.



## PP46d Digital Photo Printer
